## NOTIFICATION

The 5th May, 2006

No.Parl/Affairs-24/90. — In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (I) of section 10 of the Salary and Allowances of the Leader of Opposition in the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly Act, 2005 (Act No.1 of 2006) the Government of Arunachal Pradesh hereby makes the following Rules for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Act, namely :-

### 1. Short title and commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called the Salary and Allowances of the Leader of Opposition in the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly Rules-2006.
- (2) These rules may come in to force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

### 2. Accommodation :

Residence and Maintenance :-

- (i) The provision of supply of furniture etc, in the residence of Leader of Opposition shall be at par with the cabinet Minister's rank.
- (ii) A compensatory allowances of rupees five thousand per mensem shall be payable in lieu of government accommodation, if the Leader of Opposition resides in own house or rented house.

### 3. Travelling and daily allowances :

Travelling allowances to the Leader of Opposition and his family members shall be :-

- (i) In respect of journey to and from Itanagar to his usual place of residence outside Itanagar for the purpose of assuming and relinquishing office. The Leader of Opposition shall be entitled to T.A. as admissible to first grade officer.
- (ii) Daily allowances and travelling in respect of tours undertaken by him in discharge of his official duties whether by land, sea or air.
- (iii) While travelling on duty by railway or by road or by steamer or by air, a Leader of Opposition shall be entitled to draw travelling allowances and daily allowances at the maximum rates applicable to first grade officer of central government serving in Arunachal Pradesh. He shall be allowed to draw only half of such travelling allowance, if he travels on duty by road in a motor car provided to him.
- (iv) The Leader of Opposition may in public interest, perform journey on tour of air, on the cancellation of a journey due to official reason, the Leader of Opposition does not utilize a free air transport services may also recover in respect of journey to and from the airport actual travelling expenses or road mileage whichever is less.
- (v) A Leader of Opposition is also entitled to:-
  - (a) An advance of travelling allowance for the cost of transporting himself, members of his family in respect of the journey to Itanagar from his hometown or vice-versa. Also advance for the tours undertaken by the Leader of Opposition in the discharge of his official duties whether by land, sea, or air.

### 4. Conveyance :

- (i) A motor car with a driver shall be placed at the disposal of the Leader of Opposition for the period of the tenure of his office, provided he relinquishes office, his car shall be retained by Government.
- (ii) The cost of maintenance and POL expenditure shall be provided to the Leader of Opposition as admissible to the Cabinet Minister of Arunachal Pradesh.

**5. Telephone :**

- (i) The Leader of Opposition shall be provided telephone with STD facility one each at his residence and office.
- (ii) The installation, maintenance and rental of the telephone shall be admissible to Leader of Opposition at par with Minister of cabinet rank.

**6. Medical Attendance and Treatment :**

A Leader of Opposition and the members of his family shall be entitled, free of charge, to accommodation in hospitals maintained by the Government and also to medical treatment in accordance with the medical attendance Rules, 1944, applicable to first grade officers of the central Government serving in Arunachal Pradesh.

**7. Personal staff and Secretarial Assistance :**

The Leader of Opposition shall also be provided with necessary personal staff, such as private secretary/ personal assistance, one UDC, one typist and one peon to help him in discharge of his duties as the Leader of Opposition .
