NOTIFICATION

The 18th December, 2007

No. DTC/Estt-RR/124/2007.—In exercise of the power conferred by the provision to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Director, Trade and Commerce, in Department of Trade and Commerce, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement: (i) These rules may be called "Arunachal Pradesh, Trade and Commerce group 'A' (Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 2007 for the post of Director, Trade and Commerce."

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of issuance of this order.

(iii) They shall apply to the post as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this rule.

2. These rules shall apply to the post as specified in column 1 of the schedule annexure to the rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay: The number of the said post their classification and scale of pay attached hereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications: The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as per columns 5-14 of Schedule annexed to this rule.

5. Disqualification: No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered or contracted into marriage with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Government of Arunachal Pradesh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

6. Power to relax: Where the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Repeal and saving: All rules and procedures corresponding to these rules and procedures in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed, provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been validity made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation/ relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in this regard.
