THE ARUNACHAL PRADESH TRADE UNION (AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 2005.

1. **Short title, extent and commencement : (1)** These Regulations may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Trade Unions (Amendment) Regulations, 2005.
 2. They shall extend to whole of Arunachal Pradesh.
 3. They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. **In the Arunachal Pradesh Trade Unions Regulations, 1982 :**
 - (i) In sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 1 for the words "UNION TERRITORY" the words "STATE" shall be substituted.
 - (ii) In sub-regulation (a) of Regulation 7 for the words and figures "Rs. 10-(Rupees ten) only" the words and figures "Rs. 500 (Rupees five hundred) only" shall be substituted and in sub-regulation (b) for the words and figures "Rs. 5 (Rupees five) only" the words and figures "Rs. 250 (Rupees two hundred fifty) only" shall be substituted.
 - (iii) In Regulation 7, after sub-regulation (b) the following sub-regulations shall be inserted namely :-
 - (c) The fees chargeable for issue of Duplicate Registration Certificate shall be the 50% of fee paid for fresh registration.
 - (d) The fees chargeable for change of name of Trade Union or amalgamation shall be Rs. 50 (Rupees fifty) only.
 - (e) Mode of payment of fees : The payment of the various fees relating to Registration, change of name, Alteration of rules, etc. shall be made through Treasury Challan under Head of Account 'B' Non-Tax Revenue -0230-Labour and Employment received under the Arunachal Pradesh Trade Union Regulations, 1982.
 - (iv) In sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 15 for the words and figures "Rs.5 (Rupees five) only" the words and figures Rs. 100 (Rupees one hundred) only" shall be substituted.
 - (v) In clause (c) of sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 20 for the words "UNION TERRITORY" the word "STATE" shall be substituted.
 - (vi) In sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 25 for the words and figures "Rs. 2 (Rupees two) only" the words and figures "Rs. 50 (Rupees fifty) only" shall be substituted and in sub-regulation (2) for the words and figures "Rs. 2 (Rupees two) only" the words and figures "Rs. 10 (Rupees ten) only" shall be substituted, and in sub-regulation (4) for the words "clause 2" shall be substituted by the words "sub-regulation (2) and for the words and figures Rs. 1 (Rupee one) only" the words and figures "Rs 10 (Rupees ten) only" shall be substituted. And for the words and figures 50 (fifty paisa) only" the words and figures "Rs. 5 (Rupees five) only" shall be substituted.
