No. TPT (B) 18/89 (Part).—The existing fare structure of the Department is based on the Notification No. TPT (B)18/89 dated 16th November, 2000. Since then, there has been an all around increase in the cost of operational inputs. The prices of HSD have increased by 88%, materials/spares by 47% and salaries/wages by 25%. Since 2000, the cost per seat/km has increased from Re. 0.63 to Re. 0.88. In other words, the Department is making losses of Re. 0.25 per seat/km at present. It is therefore necessary to increase the fare by Re. 0.25 to Re. 0.88 per seat/km in the public interest.

In exercise of the powers conferred with sub-section (1) of Section 67 of the Motor Vehicle Act 1988, it is proposed to revise the freight charges and fares of the Arunachal Pradesh State Transport Services as follows :
