MEMORANDUM

The 29th December, 2006

No. PD (ES) - 28/2005.— WHEREAS, in keeping with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Gauhati dated 31st March, 2006 in WP (C) No. 605 (AP)/2005, a Memorandum was issued to Shri Anong Lego and others, the writ petitioners, to show cause as to why the anomalous and erroneous pay scale Rs. 12,000-15'200 p. m. should not be replaced by standard pay scale of Rs. 10'000-325-15'200 p. m. within 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue vide Office Order No. (PD(ES) -28/2005 dated 16th October, 2006;

AND WHEREAS, the respondents through Shri N. Pertin, Agronomist, the authorized representative of the petitioners have filed a reply dated 15th November, 2006 followed by another supplementary reply dated 21st November, 2006, claiming therein that the pay-scale of Rs. 12'000-15'200 p. m. was granted on the basis of recommendation of the Cabinet Sub-Committee constituted for the purpose, after taking into account responsibilities shouldered by officers in the grade of Dy. Director, District Agriculture Officer etc. and that the officers are enjoying the pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-15,200 for last 2 (two) years and the Finance Department's opinions regarding substitution of the anomalous and erroneous pay-scale by the standard pay-scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. is vague and that roll back of the initial basic pay from Rs. 12,000 to Rs. 10,000 would equate their initial basis pay with those in feeder grades of SDAO. Instructor, Research Officer, Peripatetic Training Officer, Subject Matter Specialist, Junior Seed Analyst, Entomologist, Plant Pathologist, Sr. Technical Assistant, Assistant Soil Chemist and Agriculture Development Officer who would be placed in the pay-scale of Rs 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. after completion of 8 years which would amount to injustice and, therefore, they should be granted the pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-375-15,200 p. m. in place of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. ;

AND WHEREAS, on examination of the contention of the petitioners, the Government is of the view that the petitioners have not made out any case for allowing them the anomalous and erroneous pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-15,200 p. m ;

NOW THEREFORE, the claims of the petitioners for continuation of the anomalous and erroneous pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-15,200 p. m. is rejected on the following grounds:

(i) The Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997, accepted by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh vide Notification No. FIN/E-II/24/2004 dated 9th October, 1997 does not provide for pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-375-15,200 p. m.

(ii) Rule-36 of the Arunachal Pradesh Rules of Executive Business, 1987, mandates that the Finance Department shall be consulted before the issue of orders upon all proposals which affect the finance of the State, in particular, proposals to add any post or abolished any post from the public service or to vary the emoluments of any post. While issuing the Officer Order No. Agri/E-12/2000-2004(Vol-I) dated 24th November, 2004, no consultations with the Finance Department was made and their concurrence was not obtained.

(iii) Rs.10,000-325-15,200 p. m. is the standard pay-scale of the post of Dy. Director in most of the Departments under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh and there is no justification for making any departure from the standard pay-scale in the case of Dy. Director (Agriculture), District Agriculture Officer and other equivalent posts in the Department of Agriculture.

(iv) The scale of pay as provided in the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997, is Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p.m. A person holding the post in the scale of pay of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. after earning 16 annual increments at the rate of Rs. 325 reaches the maximum pay of Rs. 15,200. But the same person on fixation of his pay in the anomalous and erroneous pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-375-15,200/- would never reach the maximum pay of Rs 15,200 but Rs. 15,000 or Rs. 15,375/-i.e. Rs. 175 higher in the maximum pay which is not provided for under Fundamental Rules and Supplementary Rules.

Other words, the maximum pay of Rs. 15,200 is reachable only in the pay-scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. and not in Rs. 12,000-375-15,200 p. m. Therefore, the pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-375-15,200 p. m. is not maintainable and accordingly needs to be replaced by the pay-scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. to conform to standard pattern of scale as provided under the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997.

(v) Agriculture Development Officer and others posts whose pay scale has been upgraded from Rs. 6,500-200-10,500 p. m. to Rs. 8,000-275-13,500 p. m. have been allowed a financial upgradation in the scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. after completion of 8 (eight) years of service in respective grades in order to remove stagnation resulting from pyramidal hierarchical structure of the Department. This assured upgradation of pay-scale on completion of prescribed qualifying years of service cannot be the justification for introduction of an anomalous and erroneous pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-15,200/- PM not provided for in the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997, which is the basis for scale to scale revision of pay-scales or introduction of higher pay-scales in different grades of posts in the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. Nor is the demand for grant of pay-scale of Rs. 12,000-375-16,500/- PM to the post of Deputy Director (Agriculture), DAO etc. is tenable as the said pay-scale is the approved upgraded pay-scale for the post of Joint Director (Agriculture) which is the next promotion post of the Deputy Director (Agriculture) etc. However, this demand is besides the point as the instant case is in connection with replacement of the anomalous and erroneous pay scale of Rs. 12,000-15,200 p. m. with the standard pay-scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m.

Accordingly, on the grounds stated in the foregoing paras, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order that officers in the ranks of District Agriculture Officer, DTO, Farm Manager, Deputy Director, Agronomist, Principal (GTC), STO, SPO, Project Officer etc. shall be allowed the standard pay scale of Rs. 10,000-325-15,200 p. m. with immediate effect.

This disposes of the representation dated 15th November, 2006 and 21st November, 2006 referred to in Para-2 of this Office Memorandum.
