#### DISTRICT LEVEL SPECIAL TASK FORCE COMMITTEE

The Special Task Force Committee so constituted in the district shall :-

- Ensure that effective rehabilitation measures are supplemented by strong enforcement measures to prevent further entry of children into the work force.

## Terms of Reference :

1. Bamboo Development Agency will be the nodal agency for non-forest areas.
2. To prepare perspective and annual State Level Action Plan in consonance with Mission's goals and objectives in close coordination with Bamboo Technical Support Group (BTSG) and oversee its implementation.
3. To receive funds from the national mission authority, the State Government and other sources for carrying out the mission's activities, maintain proper accounts thereof and submit utilization certificates to the concerned agencies.
4. To furnish periodic progress reports to the Ministry of Agriculture.
5. To release funds to the implementing organizations and and oversee, monitor and review the implantation of the programmes.
6. To organize base-line survey and feasibility studies in different parts (District, Sub-District, or a group of Districts) to determine the status of bamboo production, its potential and demand, and tailor assistance accordingly. Similar studies would also be undertaken for other components of the programmes ;
7. To assist and oversee the implementation of the Mission's programmes in the State through Farmers Societies, NGOs, growers' associations, self-help groups, State institutions and other similar entities ;
8. To organize Workshops, Seminars and Training Programmes for all interest groups/associations at the State level.

**Bamboo Development Agency (BDA) shall be a registered society under the Societies Registration Act 1860. Secretary (Horticulture) will initiate necessary action in this regard.**
