Following will be the terms and condition for taking over the entire liabilities of the Institutions :

1. That the Rajiv Gandhi Polytechnic shall be treated as Government Institution and the employees working in the Institution shall be governed by the relevant Rules of the State Government in-force from time to time under overall control of the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education.
2. That the Recruitment Rules for the Vocational/Teaching and the technical staff shall be regulated by the norms of AICTE or as decided by the State Council for Technical Education or State Government and the Service Rules shall be the same as applicable to the employees of State Government.
3. That all the employees both vocational and non vocational shall be treated as State Government employees with effect from 1st July, 2007 from the date of taking over of the Rajiv Gandhi Polytechnic by the State Government.
4. Leave Rules in respect of Vocational Staff shall be followed as per the guidelines of the AICTE or of the State Government as decided later on. However, leave rules in respect of non-vocational staff shall be same as applicable to the State Government employees under CCS (Leave) Rules as amended from time to time.
5. The recruitment for the faculty of the Institute shall be through the process of APPSC and state reservation policy for all kind of recruitment shall be followed. However for the Group 'B' 'C' & 'D' staff recruitment shall be done by the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education.
6. That the Principal having been declared as Head of office shall exercise financial power as per provision of GFR. Any financial involvement beyond the financial power of the Principal will require approval of the higher authority/Government.
7. That the employees EPF will be merged into GPF policies of the Government.
8. That the employees of the Institute shall be entitled to the service benefit or Pensionary benefit as is applicable to the State Government employees from the date of taking over the Institute by the State Government.
9. In case of teaching staff there will be separate seniority list which will be combined with that of the similar Institute of the State Government as and when established in future and they will be transferable amongst these institutions.

For non teaching staff, combined seniority list would be maintained with that of the staff of respective cadre of the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education and they will be placed at the bottom of such combined seniority list as per the seniority in the autonomous setup. Further, these non- teaching staff will be transferable amongst the institutions/colleges of the state or the Directorate.

10. That all the proposal including leave cases and other establishment matters relating to the Gazetted officers including members of the Faculty would be submitted to the Government through the Director of Higher and Technical Education for obtaining approval.

11. Other rules and regulation or any other matters relating to Academic establishment or service matters which are not specified here in, shall be governed by the rules and regulation of the State Government. The State Government reserves right to addition or omission of the rules, regulation or formulation of policy matters if deemed suitable under the purview of the State Government.

No. PD/LF-31/2006 PART.— The state Government has reviewed implementation of projects under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) and observed that a large number of projects have been approved/ sanctioned under RIDF from RIDF-V to RIDF-XII, most of which still remained incomplete due to thin spread of resources resulting in time and cost overruns.

Therefore, in order to streamline and rationalize the process of taking up of projects under RIDF and also to ensure timely completion of projects as well as judicious utilization of funds, the State Government has taken following decisions :

- (1) Executing departments shall ensure completion of sanctioned projects under RIDF as per milestone. Henceforth, no new schemes will be considered/ proposed under RIDF and the fund available under RIDF will be exclusively used for ongoing projects only.
- (2) The NABARD will be asked not to sanction any new project other than the ones already prioritized by the State Government during 2006-2007 until further intimation from the State Government. In the mean time, the State Government will also review the already approved projects under RIDF but awaiting sanction from NABARD and will decide if any approved project shall merit funding as per priority.
- (3) Revised estimates eligible for sanction as per NABARD guidelines only will be considered for submission to NABARD
- (4) There will be a blanket ban on submission of fresh proposals under RIDF to NABARD for at least three years i.e up to 31st March, 2010. The situation will be reviewed and appropriate decision taken thereafter.

All concerned are, therefore, requested to adhere to the above directives of the Government.

NOTIFICATION

The 8th May, 2007

No. AP/SYA-50/2004-05(Pt).— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post (s) of Sports Officer (General Arunachal Pradesh Service Group 'B') in the Department of Sports and Youth Affairs under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely :

1. Short title and commencement : (i) These rules may be called “ **the Sports Officer (Group- 'B' Non-Ministerial) Recruitment Rules, 2007**”.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

(iii) These rules shall apply to the post(s) as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay : The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 in the schedule aforesaid.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc : The method of recruitment to the said posts(s), age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualification : No person, –

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage, and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax : Where the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Selection Board/Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person(s).

6. Repeal and saving : All rules and procedures corresponding to these rules and procedures in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed, provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been validly made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in this regard.
