No. DAD-9/S&R/065.— Sub : Affixing of revenue stamps - Government Instructions thereof.

Government of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to notify for strict compliance of the following instructions by all the Ministries/Commissioners/Secretaries/Heads of Departments/Government Institutions/Government offices as well as by all public Institutions/Banks/Public Sector Undertakings/ Companies, that are carrying business within the State of Arunachal Pradesh, to affix compulsorily, revenue stamps of Re. 1 only (Rupee one) only while issuing and making any kinds of payments above Rs. 500 (Rupees five hundred) only. The revenue stamps so affixed in any Money Receipt/quittances, should be purchased only from State Treasuries within the state of Arunachal Pradesh. It should be noted that Revenue stamp purchased from outside the state of Arunachal Pradesh shall not be accepted as valid in any circumstances.

Further, it also be noted that in case of failure to do so, appropriate action shall be initiated against the defaulters under various provisions of Indian Stamp Act, 1899.

PROCEDURE FOR AFFIXING REVENUE STAMPS

- (i) Recovery of Re. 1, being revenue stamp for drawal of monthly salary etc., which is deposited into the Bank of individual's saving accounts, may be made from monthly salary bill and deducted amount of revenue receipt from revenue stamps may be deposited by Treasury Challan into the Major Head of Account “0030-Stamps & Registration” and a copy of the schedule in respect of above transaction be sent to the District Administration Department (Stamp & Registration Section), Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh Secretariat, Itanagar.
- (ii) Other than the bill not drawn through salary bill, when the amount is disbursed through Pay Register, the drawal be allowed only after affixing the revenue stamp by the drawee for Re. 1 against the amount for more than Rs. 500.

- (iii) Those payments which would be made by cheque or draft (viz. to contractors, pensioners, etc.), the payee must be given a receipt where the payee would authenticate by his signature on the revenue stamp affixed thereon which would be kept for record.
- (iv) Pre-receipted voucher affixing revenue stamp for Re. 1 from the drawer of the amount may be obtained along with the isolated claims (like MR, TA, LTC Bills etc.) stating Bank Account Number and particular of the bill before submitting final payment.
