No. GS/ESTT-10/2005.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order that the Arunachal Pradesh Secretariat Subordinate Service Rules 1989, as amended from time to time, will henceforth be applicable in *toto* to regulate the method of recruitment and conditions of service of persons appointed to non-gazetted (Group 'C') Ministerial and non-Ministerial posts borne under Governor's Secretariat Cadre, Raj Bhavan, Arunachal Pradesh, as follows :

1. Lower Division Clerk
2. Upper Division Clerk
3. Assistant
4. Personal Assistant (Stenographer Grade III)
5. Senior Personal Assistant (Stenographer Grade II)

Further, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order that the existing Recruitment Rules for the Gazetted posts of Section Officer, Private Secretary, Under Secretary and Deputy Secretary under Arunachal Pradesh Civil Secretariat, will also be applicable in *toto* to the following posts borne under Governor's Secretariat Cadre, Raj Bhavan, Arunachal Pradesh.

ORDER

No. DAD-23/S&R/05.—WHEREAS it is expedient so to do the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Act. No. 2 of 1899) is pleased to direct that whenever, in any area in the State, there is shortage of stamps or the required stamp of denominations of Rs. 20, Rs. 10, Rs. 5, Rs. 2 and Re. 1 for payment of duty on any instrument are not available, the adhesive Court fee stamp of required denomination issued by the State Treasuries of Arunachal Pradesh shall be used for the purpose of payment of stamp duty chargeable on instrument under any law in force for the time being in the State.

The Manner in which an adhesive Court fee stamp shall be used are indicated below for strict compliance :—

(i) Every instrument written upon paper stamped with an adhesive Court fee stamp shall be written in such manner that the stamp may appear clearly on the face of the instrument and cannot be used for or applied to any other instrument.

(ii) Whoever affixes any adhesive stamp to any instrument chargeable with duty which has been executed by any person shall, when affixing such stamp, cancel the same so that it cannot be used again in the manner stipulated under section 12 of Indian Stamp Act (Act 2 of 1899).
