Subject :- Reservation in Group-A posts/services under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh-clarification regarding.

No. OM-38/76(Vol-II) Pt.—After issue of clarification on classification of posts/services under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh vide office memorandum No. OM-42/2004 dated 31st August, 2006, it has been brought to the notice of this Department that various appointing authorities of works departments are treating the posts of Assistant Engineers as Group-B. Accordingly, appointing authorities are filling up the vacant posts of Assistant Engineer against promotion quota, applying the reservation ratio of 80:20 in spite of the fact that the post carrying scale of pay of Rs. 8000-275-13500 is Group-A post after enhancement of the scale of pay of the post from Rs. 6500-200-10500 vide Government order No. SPWD-040/97-98/Pt-I dated 26th May, 1998.

There is no pending claims and objection in the matter of reservation in the posts of Assistant Engineer against the promotion quota. All the concerned incumbents serving in various works department as Junior Engineer have accepted the reservation ratio of 80:20 in promotion to Assistant Engineer post is in order and justified.

In view of above position, the actions which are already taken by appointing authorities as pointed out above, should not be reopened or reviewed as it stands accepted by all the concerned staff (APST & Non-APST) of the works departments.

Therefore, the classification of various posts/services under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh as clarified vide office memorandum No. OM-42/2004 dated 31st August, 2006 shall be effective from the date of issue of the office memorandum i.e. 31st August, 2006 only.

NOTIFICATION

No. DTC/DEV/104/2007/418-429.—The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order the rent structure for allotment of various Type of Residential and Non-Residential building created under the Department of Trade and Commerce, Government of Arunachal Pradesh in the Border Trade Centre. This notification shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette. The Guideline/Terms and condition and rent structures are as follows :—

1. The District Administration or its nominee shall be the Allotting Authority.
2. All the employees of state/central/PSUs/other organizations and private are eligible for allotment subject to the terms and conditions therein.
3. The allottee shall sign an undertaking as in Annexure-A.

4. All the private allottee shall have to deposit a security amount equivalent to twelve (12) months rent value of the allotted building to the Allotting Authority. The security amount shall be kept under the custody of the allotting authority and shall be returned back to the allottee at the time of vacation of the building after deducting recoverable dues (if any) from the allottee. The amount so recovered shall be deposited to the Managing Director, APEIDA cum Director of Trade and Commerce, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar through a Bank Draft payable at SBI, Itanagar.

5. The allottee shall pay the rent of the building every month to the allotting authority.

6. The Allotting Authority shall deposit the rent in the manner as mentioned in Sl. No. 4 above and a monthly report showing the amount of rent received should be furnished to the Department of Trade and Commerce, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Udyug Sadan, Ground Floor, Itanagar.

7. If an allottee's outstanding rent exceed more than twelve (12) months, then District Administration should evict him forcefully and his security deposit be forfeited and deposited into Government treasury or recovered from his salary (which ever is applicable).

8. All the charges of electricity bill, water charge etc should be borned by the allottee.

9. Minor repairing/renovation of the building which shall include white washing, painting etc. shall be borned by the allottee. However, major repairing/renovation of the building (if any) should be forwarded to the Department of Trade and Commerce for funding by the executing agency with duly certified by the District Administration.

10. In the event of posting of regular officers and staff of the Directorate of Trade and Commerce and Customs and other agencies related to border trade activities in the locality, they will be given top priority for allotment of residential/non-residential building. However they will not be charged rent. The existing civic charges as notified by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh vide No. DUD/Acctt-76/2001-02 dated 9th April, 2007 shall applicable to them.

Sub :- Personnel Policies for Recruitment and engagement of Staff under National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005.

No. CD (PLG) 46/06 (NREGA).— The Government of India has passed National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 to be implemented through out the Country. In the second phase Lohit and Changlang district has been considered for implementation of the scheme with effect from 1st April, 2007 in Arunachal Pradesh.

The Act provides to ensure 100 days guaranteed wage employment to every house in Rural Areas whose adult members of the family volunteer to do unskilled manual labour work. Sampoorna Gramin Rozgar Yojana (SGRY) has been merged into National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme.

As per the Act there has a provision for engagement and recruitment of various categories of posts to be filled up under National Rural Employment Guarantee Programme at State, District, Block and Gram Panchayat Level respectively for effective implementation of NREGA Programme.

1. There will be no recruitment on regular basis. All the posts under the scheme shall be filled up on contractual basis on production of Deed of Agreement between DC-cum-District Programme Coordinator on behalf of State Government and candidate for engagement for a period of six months initially, further appointment for another terms will be subject to necessity and requirement if found suitable also available of fund.

2. The DC-cum-District Programme Coordinator shall be the appointing and cadre controlling authority of the employees at respective district. Appointment should be through open and transparent manner. All posts are to be advertised in local dailies and in one national newspaper.

3. Preferences of recruitment will be given to candidates having requisite qualification from local village, Anchal or District respectively (in order of preference).

4. Bio-data along with photograph of the selected candidate should be sent to the Directorate of RD for maintaining records.

5. The State Programme Coordinator may sough any clarification in case of any recruitment under the Act.

6. Any rules herein not covered shall governed by Government instructions issued from time to time.
