Subject : Payment of pension through Authorised bank - credit of pension to joint bank Account operated by a pensioner with his/her spouse.

No. DA/PEN/14/87 VOL-III/89.—Under the existing scheme for payment of pension through Public Sector Bank, a pensioner is entitled to receive his/ her pension by getting it credited to a saving/current bank account operated individually by him/her. Para - 7 of the 'scheme for payment of pension through Public Sector Banks' issued vide Finance Department Notification No. DA/PEN/14/87 VOL-III/89 dated 16th August 1989 lays down the procedure for credit of pension to pensioner's bank account. Credit of pension to a Joint Account is not permitted under the existing system.

2. Government of India has recently decided to permit credit of pension also to a Joint Account operated by the pensioner with his / her spouse in whose favour an authorization for family pension exists in the PPO.

3. After careful consideration of the matter, it has been decided to permit credit of pension also to a joint account operated by pensioner with his / her spouse in whose favour an authorization for family pension exists in the pension payment order (P.P.O). The joint account of the pensioner with the spouse could be operated either by 'former or survivor', or 'either or survivor' basis subject to the following terms and conditions.

- (a) Once pension has been credited to the pensioner's bank account, the liability of the Government/ bank ceases. No further liability arises, even if the spouse wrongly draws the amount without the knowledge of the pensioner.
- (b) As pension is payable only during the life of a pensioner, his/ her death shall be intimated by the spouse to the bank at the earliest and in any case within one month of the demise, so that the bank does not continue crediting monthly pension to the joint account with the spouse, after the death of the pensioner. If, however, any amount has been wrongly credited to the joint account, it shall be recoverable from the joint account or his/ her account held by the pensioner/ spouse either individually or jointly. The legal heirs, successors executors etc. shall also be liable to refund any amount, which has been wrongly credited to the joint account.
- (c) Existing pensioners desiring to get their pension credited to a joint account as indicated above are required to submit an application in the enclosed form to the concern bank branch, from where they are presently drawing pension. The pensioner's spouse intoken of having accepted the terms would also sign this. These instructions are also applicable to the Government employees who will be retiring after issue of this memo.
- (d) Opening of Joint Account with any other person for credit of pension, except the spouse in whose favour family pension is authorised in the PPO, shall not be permissible. Family pensioners are not covered under this revised scheme.

- (b) Payment of Arrears of Pensioners (nomination) Rules, 1983 would continue to be applicable to the joint account with pensioner's spouse. Thus, if there is an accepted nomination in accordance with Rule 5 and 6 of these Rules, arrears mentioned in the Rules will be payable to the nominee.

NOTIFICATION

The 30th November, 2006

No. LA/ESTT-10/2006.—In exercise of the powers conferred clause (3) of Article 187 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh after consultation with the Speaker of the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly, is pleased to make the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of **UDC-cum-Receptionist**, Legislative Assembly Secretariat.

1. Short title and commencement : (i) These rules may be called "Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly group 'C' (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 2006 for the post of UDC-cum-Receptionist."

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(iii) They shall apply to the post as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this rule.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay : The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached hereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications : The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as per columns 5-14 of Schedule annexed.

4. Disqualification : No person, —

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered or contracted into marriage with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Government of Arunachal Pradesh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax : Where the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, after consultation with the Speaker of the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh and as adopted by the Speaker in relation to the Legislature Secretariat in terms of para 6 of the Notification No. LA/Estt-13/87 (1) dated 14th June, 1990 if any from time to time in this regard.
