No. MFW-2003/94.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director (IEC) in the Department of Health & Family Welfare under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement : (i) These rules may be called “ **the Deputy Director (IEC) Recruitment Rules, 2006**”.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

(iii) These rule shall apply to the post as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexured to the rules.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay : The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 in the Schedule aforesaid.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification. : The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters regulating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualification : No person, —

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax : Where the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Section Board/Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

6. Repeal and saving : All rules and procedures corresponding to these rules and procedures in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed, provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been validity made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in this regard.
