No. MDTC/PUB/2006/450.— RECRUITMENT RULE TO THE POST OF GENERAL MANAGER (MINING).

**1. Short title and commencement :** (i) These rules may be called “the **Recruitment Rules for the Post(s) of General Manager (Mining)**.”

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of approval of Board of Directors of APMTDCL.

(iii) These rules shall apply to the post as specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to the rules.

**2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay :** The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 in the Schedule aforesaid.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications :** The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

**4. Disqualification :** No person, –

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ;

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post(s) :

Provided that the Management of APMDTCL/Managing Director of APMDTCL may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so, doing exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

**5. Power to relax :** Whether the Management of APMDTCL/Managing Director of APMDTCL is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

**6. Repeal and saving :** All rules and procedures corresponding to these rules and procedures in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed, provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been validly made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of person, in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in this regard.
