No. HMB(A)-23/06(Pt-V).—In compliance with the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the Writ Petition (Civil) No. 310 of 1996 Prakash Singh and others Vs. Union of India and others, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute a Police Complaints Authority at the State level in Arunachal Pradesh to look into the complaints against police officers of all the ranks in the State Police.

The State Police Complaints Authority shall be headed by a retired Judge of High Court/Supreme Court, chosen by the State Government out of a panel of names proposed by the Chief Justice. This authority shall be assisted by three to five members depending upon the volume of complaints in the State and they shall be selected by the State Government from a panel prepared by the State Public Service Commission. The panel shall include members from amongst retired civil servants, police officers or officers from any other department, or from the civil society. They would work whole time for the authority and would have to be remunerated for the service rendered by them. For the purpose of regular staff to conduct field enquiries this authority may utilize the services of retired investigator from the CID, Intelligence, Vigilance or any other organization.

The State Police Complaints Authority would take cognizance of only allegations of serious misconduct by the police personnel/officers, which would include incidents involving death, grievous hurt or rape in police custody and may also enquire into allegations of extortion, land/house grabbing or any incident involving serious abuse of authority. The recommendation of the Complaints Authority, for any action, departmental or criminal, against a police personnel/officer shall be binding on the concerned authority.

The Under Secretary of the State Vigilance Department shall serve as Secretary of the State Police Complaints Authority and look after the day-to-day correspondence and records of the Authority, and the Vigilance Department will also provide officers of the appropriate level whenever the State Police Complaints Authority so directs.

The term for the chairperson/members of the State Police Complaints Authority should be of four years of exceeding two terms.
