Over 100 Register for Pre-recruitment training to Indian Army

PASIGHAT, April 14: Over 100 local youths from East Siang, Siang, Upper Siang, Lower Dibang Valley, West Siang districts have registered for the training have registered at Pasighat for Pre-recruitment Training to join Indian Army. The training is being conducted at JN College Pasighat, coordinated by AAUN Foundation in association with Military Station Sigar and East Siang District Administration.

The youth were motivated by Deputy Commissioner Tamiyo Tatak, Colonel Ankur Kuln of Military Station Sigar, Vice President AAUN Foundation Tabung Ering and Group Captain M Panging VM Retd, Secretary AAUN Foundation.

The final recruitment is planned at Jairampur during 10-13 May next. Similar Pre-recruitment training was carried out a few months back by AAUN Foundation in association with Military Station Sigar and eight local youth were selected for recruitment to Army. Secretary AAUN Foundation, Group Captain M Panging VM Retd informed that the District Administration is providing support and all candidates are being given refreshments and reading/writing materials. He also informed that this time focus is more on theory classes for written tests as last time most candidates could not qualify in the written tests. More classes and written tests are being conducted to prepare the candidates. It is expected that more youth will get selected this time. Selection of more youth from Arunachal Pradesh to join Indian Army will provide gainful employment to local youth and strengthen national integration.

Mein while explaining the outcome of his interactions with Global President and CEO of US based NeoDocto Foundation, Mr Madhukar Sanneerappa who had called on him on Tuesday informed that the foundation had extended their willingness to provide assistance and help the State Govt in eradicating malaria. Elaborating on NeoDocto foun-

date Inc, Sanneerappa informed that the foundation is a health-based IT company headquartered in Manhattan, New York. It believes that everyone on this planet should get 360-degree care and works forward to achieve this through its various 28 services, through creating small ecosystems between doctors, patients and other partners in health care. It has a huge potential to provide maximum service through its offices in 81 countries, he added.

He said that his foundation is now working to eradicate malaria from Asia-Pacific region and has been traveling all through India to collaborate with different states and charitable institutions. Governor visits Ziro



RAJBHAVAN, April 12:

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra, (Rtd.) reviewed the status of the implementation of the national and state flagship programs in the conference hall of the circuit house, Ziro.

Addressing the HoDs the Governor called for people friendly governance. The District Administration should traverse that extra mile to ensure that people are benefitted and governance reaches all the sections of the society. Public servants are responsible to the people and should work with transparency, accountability, continuity and must subject their action to audit, review and do the mid course corrections wherever needed.

"A society will embark on a speedy developmental path if the women are educated. We should, therefore, ensure 100% literacy for the women. Every individual in the society should contribute to improve and streamline the spread of education in the state," He further added.

He also called for gainfully engaging the youths so that their energy is channelized. They should be encouraged to take up the popular pursuits like football, fine arts and music to wean them away from drug and gun culture. He also reviewed the army recruitment rally preparations in the dis-

trict. "We need maximum number of home grown soldiers. All of us should encourage our able bodied eligible youth to avail this opportunity and join the Indian army. The recruitment in Army of 2000 strong Arunachal youth is my goal which I want to achieve in 2018-19"

Emphasising on Swachh Bharat Mission he said that swachh-tashould start from our homes. Every individual should take part in Swachta Abhiyan and inculcate cleanliness habits. He directed the UD department to find out and use effective ways of waste management as unplanned dumping cannot be a permanent solution for solid waste management.

He further called for effective implementation of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana which aims at providing LPG connection to every household. This scheme should be sincerely implemented as it would save our mothers and sisters from the smoky chul-lahs, he added.

Our Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's aim is to provide lights to those rural people who have never seen lights through the DDUGJY scheme. This will revolutionise their way of life. We should, therefore, sincerely implement this scheme.

World Earth Day

World Earth Day is celebrated every year as an annual event by the people all across the world on 22nd of April in order to increase the awareness among people about the environmental safety as well as to demonstrate the environmental protection measures. First time, the world earth day was celebrated in the year 1970 and then started celebrating annually on global basis by almost 192 countries.

World Earth Day observance was started to celebrate as an annual event to get national support in order to better take care of the environmental safety by solving its issues. In 1969, there was a peace activist of the San Francisco named John McConnell who actively involved in starting this event and proposed a day to get together for the environmental safety. John McConnell had chosen this event to be celebrated in the spring equinox on 21st of March in 1970 whereas United States Wisconsin Senator Gaylord Nelson had chosen this event to be celebrated on 22nd of April in 1970.

They had contacted the people to join this event to get together for solving their environmental issues for better future. During the first time celebration of the earth day millions of people shown their interest and participated to understand the motto of the event. Instead of deciding one date for the celebration of the earth day, it has been started celebrating on both of the dates. Generally, the earth day event celebration starts with the common practice of new trees plantation in the required areas worldwide.

For founding the earth day celebration date on 22nd of April, United States Wisconsin Senator Gaylord Nelson was honored later with the Presidential Medal of Freedom Award for his participation in great job. Later, the 22nd of April as an Earth Day was focused globally by the original national coordinator, Denis Hayes in the year 1990 among almost 141 nations. Most of the earth day communities celebrate it for the whole week with the name Earth Week to focus on many environmental issues. In this way, 22nd of April 1970 has been marked as the anniversary of the modern environmental movement.

Earth Day 1970 was established to raise the public awareness for self consciousness, other living organisms, controlling the anti-war protest movement as well as keeping the environmental issues in front of the people. A big tragedy behind establishing the event of earth day celebration by the founder Gaylord Nelson (a U.S. Senator from Wisconsin) was tragedy of the massive oil spill in the Santa Barbara, California in 1969. This tragedy led the Gaylord Nelson towards enhancing the public consciousness for the air, water and soil pollution as well as implementing the environmental protection measures.

Govt to take up menstrual hygiene on mission mode: Felix

NAHARLAGUN, April 17:

2 day workshop programme on Menstrual Hygiene Management as a part of Swachh Bharat Divas is being held under Swachh Bharat Mission in collaboration with Mumbai based NGO, Red is the New Green in Association with Aga Khan Health Services, India here at Banquet Hall Itanagar today.

The programme aims at promoting good menstrual hygiene by providing health education to girls and women on menstrual and menstrual hygiene, increased community action to improve access to clean toilets with water, both at home and school, promoting the availability and use of sanitary products and enabling safe disposal of sanitary products.

Minister PHE & WS, IPR & Printing, Bamang Felix who graced the occasion as Chief Guest, while feeling the need for good menstrual hygiene for health and dignity for girls and women which is very essential, said the state government will take up the

recommendations made by experts on menstrual hygiene in the state on a 'mission mode', the way it did in achieving the open-defecation status.

"Forward the recommendations to the government and we will take care of it, he said

As ASHA workers, already have the advantage of being in close contact with women in the community, they should take the issues very seriously at the ground level as they can make a substantial difference to menstrual hygiene practices in the community. Menstrual Hygiene can be promoted in the community and in School and it will be best by starting with adolescence girls, although other women in the reproductive age group would also benefit from the information and access to sanitary products, the Minister added.

The Minister further said, responsibility does not only lies on the government but all the citizen of the state and country, it is our collective responsibility to educate and create

awareness amongst all about the basic elements of menstruation and menstrual hygiene, proper use and safe disposal of sanitary napkins and how to communicate the benefits of sanitary napkins and motivate girls in the use of sanitary napkins.

The Minister, advised the resources persons to have brainstorming discussions on all aspects of menstrual hygiene in the 2 day workshop programme and recommend necessary issues to the government so that the issues can be taken up as utmost importance and the target of the menstrual hygiene mission be achieve before time.

Earlier, there was a panel discussion with the resource persons like Deane De Mendes; founder of Red is the new Green, and its members Dr. KrantiRayamane and Dr. MadhuriRayamane, ASHA worker and Chief Engineers of the department where they discussed problems face by them in educating about menstrual hygiene,

problems faced by adolescence girls, how it is still a taboo in our society although menstruation is a natural, normal biological process experience by all adolescence girls and women yet it is not spoken about openly causing unnecessary embarrassment and shame, where Social activist like Toko Mina, PonungMoyong, CDO were amongst the many participants who highlighting the lack of toilets and water supply in schools in the state.

There are over 50, 000 adolescent girls in the state and a little over 6000 anganwadicentres, and most of them lack proper hygiene and water supply, Moyong said.

The 2 day workshop programme will discussed reproductive system- female & male, process of menstruation, menstruation management, hygiene measures, preparedness, safe disposal, problem faced during menstruation, pain in abdomen, communication, planning sessions with adolescents, book keeping and records etc.

Dwelling on the programs implemented by the ICDS department he said, "The social assistance provided to the old and disabled people through the ICDS department should be done by DBT. The Director, ICDS should motivate and ensure all the beneficiaries to open bank accounts."

He also called for ensuring that the abandoned children at the children's home should be treated with sensitivity and due care and imparted skill development training. They should be motivated and encouraged to join the mainstream of society. He said that he would make all efforts in locating the parents of a child from Assam now lodged in the children home at Ziro.

For various bank related schemes launched by the government, the department concerned should sincerely follow up the cases with the banks and ensure written correspondence from the banks, he further added.

for successful implementation of the welfare and development schemes for which he said, total participation and cooperation of the public is a must. Sangken celebrated

ITANAGAR, April 15: The annual 3-day Water Festival popularly known as Sangken-begun on Saturday with traditional throwing of water on each other, onrevelers and pedestrians alike, amidst euphoric enthusiasm and colour. Sangken is a celebration that embraces goodwill, love, compassion and thankfulness, using water as the means of expression. The festival is celebrated as the traditional Buddhist New Year's Day by the Tai Khamti, Singpho and Tangsa (Tikhak) communities across the State. One of the main traditions that form part of Sangken is to pour water on each other in mirth and to celebrate the festivity. The significance of water is to wash away bad luck and start the New Year on a new note.

People, young and old, dressed in their best traditional attire thronged Buddha Vihara of their respective villages at the designated time of 11:09:05 AM on April 14 and brought out the statues of Lord Buddha to be placed at the makeshift temporary shrine called Kyongfra Sangken after paying certain obeisance to the Triple Gems-the Buddha, the Dhamma and the Sangha.

Thereafter, water pouring on Buddha statues which is considered as an iconic ritual of this festival was performed and will continue till the festival concludes on April 16 (Monday) at exactly 03:13:47 PM. The statues of Lord Buddha will be kept in the makeshift temporary shrine till the end of the Sangken festival celebration.

After performing the traditional rituals of offering candles, flowers and the bathing of the Buddha, revellers at the Buddha viharas erupted in merriment and

splashed with bucket-loads of water unto each other and people in the streets whether they are taking part in the celebration or not. Sharing of homemade sweets and dishes also form integral part of this festival.

Celebrations take places across several villages but the majority of people will never fail to take part in the celebration of Kongmukham (Golden Pagoda) Tengapani, Namsai, Chongkham, Epong and Phaneng as people consider this places at Timet (sacred place). People from Namsai district also visit Buddha Vihara at Kalioni (KarbiAnglong), Assam which is also considered very sacred to celebrate the Sangken festival.

At Kongmukham (Golden Pagoda), Noy-Chenam (Tengapani): Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein was accorded warm reception upon his arrival by the members of Tai Khamti Heritage and Literary Society (TKHLS). Parliamentary Secretary (Environment & Forest) Chow Tewa Mein, former MLA Namsai, Nang Sati Mein also took part in the celebration of Sangken festival at Kongmukham, Tengapani.

He joined in with the people of Namsai to celebrate the water festival at Pariyatti Sasana Buddha Vihara Namsai. He participated with others in the traditional ritual of bringing out of statues of Lord Buddha from main temple to temporary makeshift shrine. He also performed the ritual of pouring scented water on the statues of Lord Buddha to invoke the blessings of Lord Buddha for peace, harmony, good luck and good health.
