Governor meets Defence Minister



ITANAGAR, Aug. 2:
The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd.) met the Defence Minister Smt. Nirjala Sitharaman at New Delhi on 2nd August last. They discussed about recruitment of more youth from the State in the Armed Forces.

The Governor expressed gratitude to the Defence minister for her initiating necessary steps to maintain peace and tranquillity in the Frontier State of Arunachal Pradesh and also addressing the basic needs of the local communities living in the border areas through Army units located in the frontiers. He also conveyed the goodwill of the people of the State for the new Arunachal Scout Battalion.

The Governor, who has been spear heading an initiative with the serving Armed Forces Officers of Arunachal Pradesh, called, 'Pay Back to Society Group' (PBSG), informed the minister that under the PBSG initiative, the officers will be coming to their Home State Arunachal Pradesh and visit various schools and colleges to motivate the youth to join the Indian Armed Forces. He opined that this step will definitely motivate many more youth of the State to be in the Armed Forces and defending the nation.

The Governor, who has toured all the districts and visited last administrative circle on the international boundaries, shared his observations with the Defence Minister. He suggested for concerted effort in addressing the issues under Border Area Development programmes.

The Governor requested the Defence Minister, who is doing a research on Idu Mishmi Tribe, for her visit and addressing the Idu Mishmi people about the social challenges of the community, including, marriage, taboos, culture practices and suicide cases. He shared his concern and discussed about a holistic approach to the problems. The Governor, after studying the problems during his District Tour to Dibang Valley and Lower Dibang Valley Districts, had deputed a team of medical officers and psychiatrists to study the issues of the community.

The Defence minister assured the Governor that she would visit Arunachal Pradesh whenever invited. She conveyed her good wishes to the people of Arunachal Pradesh through the Governor. She said that as she has a close affiliation with Mishmi Tribe, Arunachal Pradesh is always close to her heart.

The event was inaugurated by Deputy Commissioner Smti Mamata Riba along with all assembled Gaon Buras and public of Walong Circle. The medical and veterinary camps were crowd pullers. Medical/Dental Examination blood, OAB sampling and distribution of IEC Materials was carried out by the Medical department. The Veterinary department distributed medicines for cattle, mithuns, pigs and goats. Distribution of saplings by Forest Department, and of Seeds and utilities by Agriculture and Horticulture departments were carried out. DRDA Shri Mito Dirchi and other Officers travelled on foot to Musai Village crossing 200 mtr Foot Suspension Bridge over the mighty Lohit river to supervise and inspect the usage of freshly completed Additional Classroom, Teacher's quarter, Skill Development Centre and Children's playground as a part of Model Village infrastructure funded under BADP for the people of the Village. Distribution of LED lamps under Ujjala Scheme by APEDA, Sports articles by the Department of Sports and Youth Affairs, lifesaving implements by Disaster Management department were very well received. In the social sphere, on the spot registration for flagship programmes like Dulari Kanya Scheme, issuance of Old Age Pension by ICDS, issuance of Registration Cards and distribution of welfare kits by the Department of Labour & Employment and APL&OCWB and issuance of Births, ST, PRC and Income Certificates by the General Administration were highlights of the day.

Minister KamlungMosang called on MoS for Food & Public Distribution Consumer Affairs and Trade & Commerce C. R Choudhary



ITANAGR, Aug 2:
Food & Civil Supplies minister KamlungMosang called on Union Minister of state for Food & Public Distribution Consumer Affairs and Trade & Commerce C. R Choudhary on 1st and 2nd August at Udyog Bhawan and Krishi Bhawan respectively. On the first day Mosang submitted a 10 point Memorandum to MoS who appreciated the facts on table and called for a detailed meeting on the second day with senior officers of the Ministry of Food & Public Distribution to address the issues raised by the State. Mosang submitted all the issues relating to Implementation of National Food Security Act and other challenges unique to the frontier and cash-strapped state.

MoS Choudhary has assured to enhance the Fair Price Shop (FPS) Dealers Margin & Transportation rate of NFSA food grains. Presently the FPS Dealers margin is Rs. 143/- per quintal which needs to be enhanced to Rs. 200/- per Quintal for the viability of running an FPS in remote location. Moreover, a flat Rs. 100/- per quintal is fixed by GoI for transportation of NFSA food grains out of which Centre and state

matching share is of the Ratio @75: 25 irrespective of the distance covered thereby forcing the budget deficit state to bear the remaining Rs. 252/- per quintal against actual transportation cost of Rs. 327/- per quintal to deliver food grains from FCI Base Depots to FPS.

Choudhary also assured to allocate foodgrains under welfare scheme for education institutions at increased scale meant for welfare Institutions/ Hostels to cater to 84, 391 ST/ SC/OBC boarder students. It will ease the huge burden on state government to feed these institutions as there is no provision under NFSA to allocate food grains for the same. He also assured more funds for construction of Godowns for advance storage of food grains.

Union Minister advised the state govt to send proposal for the Heli-lifting of NFSA food grains to the 14 air-fed administrative circles/ CPO centers. The MoS opined while Mosang submitted that there is no surface communication in the international border areas. The people residing along the international border areas are facing acute shortage of food grains as these places are not climatically suitable for cultivation, there

Chief Minister expressed grief and concern over the huge fire mishap at Roing

ITANAGAR, Aug. 1:
Chief Minister Pema Khandu expressed grief and concern over the huge fire mishap at Roing that has devoured a major section of Middle Market Line of the township.

"I am saddened by the devastating fire that devoured one-fourth of Roing market yesterday evening though no loss of lives has been reported. At this moment of sorrow and loss, I pray for strength and courage to those affected and stand by them in this excruciating moment," he said.

Khandu expressed gratitude to the Indian Army, Central Paramilitary Forces, Assam Police Fire Services and Border Roads Organization for assisting the State Police in battling the raging inferno.

"I am in constant touch with the District Administration taking stock of the situation. The District administration has been instructed to provide immediate relief and assess the loss and damage. One of my minister colleagues has also been asked to rush to Roing to monitor the relief work," he informed.

The district administration informed that the fire that started around 8.15 pm Tuesday could be contained after fire fighting operations through

the night. Two fire fighting trucks from Chapakhowa in Assam, one from Tezu, two from Roing fire service and three tankers from BRO and one from PHED were pressed into service to douse the spreading fire.

At least 20 families have been rendered homeless. However no casualty has been reported till now. The district administration has opened up the government Circuit House and the Anchal Samiti hall at Roing where eleven families consisting of fifty-one members have been given accommodation with food. Immediate relief materials like tarpaulin, bedding, drinking water have been provided.

As per official sources 35 shops have been completely devoured by the fire mostly run by non-APSTs. The administration has constituted a assessment committee with a Circle Officer as chairman and the DySP, DDMO and DFCSO as members. The committee will submit its assessment report by Thursday.

Immediate monetary relief as relief has been provided to all the victim families by the administration as per norms.

Situation is under control and administration is keeping strict vigil.

The Governor impressed upon the Union Minister for enhancing the quality of higher education in the State to match the requirements of employment avenues. He emphasised on value based education for qualified, skilled

and trained human resource. The Governor requested the HRD Minister for expediting the process of appointments of Director for NIT and Vice Chancellor for RGU.

The Minister assured that the appointments will be done very soon.

The Governor requested the HRD Minister for Kendriya Vidyalayas in the border towns of the State, i.e. Taksing / Limiking in Upper Subansiri District, Mechukha in West Siang District, Tuting / Singa / Gelling in Upper Siang District and Kibithoo / Walong in Anjaw District. ORDER**WHEREAS,**

It has been reported that due to incessant rain fall, various locations within the Capital Complex are affected by flood/landslide causing threat to the lives and properties of the residents/people.

AND WHEREAS,

It has been reported that due to incessant rain various roads including NH415 within Capital Complex has been damaged resulting into traffic congestions and inconvenience to the commuters.

AND WHEREAS

The traffic movement through NH415 from Naharlagun to Itanagar has been restricted due to landslide at various points of NH415.

AND WHEREAS,

As per Section No.33 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 "The District Authority may by order require any officer or any Department at the district level or any local authority to take such measures for the prevention of mitigation of disaster, or to effectively respond to it, as may be necessary, and such officer or Department shall be bound to carry out such order".

AND WHEREAS,

As per Section No.34 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 "For the purpose of assisting, protecting or providing relief to the community, in response to any threatening disaster situation or disaster, the District Authority may -

- a) Give directions for the release and use of resources available with any Department of the Government and the local authority in district; ...
- b) control and restrict vehicular traffic to, from and within, the vulnerable or affected area; ..."
- h) recommend to any Department of the Government of the State or any authority or body under that Government at the district level to take such measures as are necessary in its opinion."

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, Talom Dupak, APCS, I/c District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Itanagar Capital Complex exercising powers conferred upon me under Section 33, 34 (a) (b) and (h) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, do hereby order as follows: -

1. The vegetable vendors/shops along the NH415 from Todo Hotel to Dree Ground are directed to evacuate themselves to safer locations. If anybody fails to do so, the District Administration shall not be responsible and for any loss of their life and property.
2. The SP, Capital Complex is hereby directed to deploy adequate traffic personnel for regulation of traffic in the NH415 and Naharlagun-July-Itanagar road.
3. The Executive Engineer, Naharlagun Highway Division is directed to restore the NH415 for vehicular traffic at the earliest.
4. Vehicular traffic from Naharlagun to Itanagar and vice-versa may be diverted through July.
5. Further, it is reiterated that people residing unauthorizedly on river beds, nearby natural nullahs / streams and cutting sides of hillock without taking adequate protection measures are living at their own risk and administration shall not be responsible for loss of life and property in such unauthorized settlements.

UNEMPLOYMENT: A Cause and Minimization through Placements.

Unemployment, mean jobless and want of work or offer to work but no works available as per academic qualification. In case of unemployment, availability of requisite qualifications, having degree or diploma for job but no jobs is available, according to qualification, possess by an individual. This can well be termed as Unemployment and if employed below his professional degree, that employment can be termed as underemployment. In fact, in general understanding this unemployment is a social status of employable youths having no earning through employment and in true sense it is an economic status of employable persons.

To eradicate disease or epidemic is possible on advancement of medical science. Now diseases or epidemic like cholera, small pox, polio, leprosy and others have been controlled. Same is the case of diseases like malaria, tuberculosis and cancer, and are on table to be contained or controlled. Even, it is expected that other diseases can also be controlled if medical science can strike in its research. If no definite result is made, preventive measures with minimization on magnitude of such impact can always be expected, whereas, it is not possible in field of unemployment so long ratio of qualified youths are greater than opportunities available are scarce and limited.

To draw a policy line to control or eradicate social evil transferred from generation to generation is hard task but in long run such evils whether it is a kind of legacy can be removed through light of knowledge and reformation since education is ultimate wisdom to reckon with. True to education and thereby in transforming economy one thing that can hardly be avoided is present day modern economy where education begets unemployment and in modern day society it is an evil as product of education. There is no solution to eradicate unemployment except minimization through effective employment base education policy and economic measures.

Hunger, starvation, malnutrition are sum amount of social and economic conditions of underprivileged society and is a result of no means to fulfil their hunger and is result of joblessness earning livelihood.

Lowest stratum of people are to face the brunt of such social and economic conditions and thereby hunger, starvation and malnutrition take human toll due to poor nutritional management as a result of poor economic conditions. This is a general view and does not concern to conditions of our society alone.

The terminology, unemployment in Arunachal is widely used among youths in various fields. Here, lot of unemployed organisations in various fields viz. civil, electrical, electronic, veterinary, agriculture, horticulture, tourism, medical and general degree holder of science, arts and commerce are also unemployed and have their organisations. Truly unemployment is a grim situation in Arunachal since youths entirely depends on government jobs. All North Eastern states including Arunachal Pradesh falls under small state category having no industries, factories and employable estates to look after the employment of youths, such state can hardly take the risk of employing youths produced by various academic institutes annually.

The state Governor must have realised this grim unemployment situation and has constituted a committee to examine and formulate for employment generation. The drawn members from various institutes like North Eastern Regional Institute of Science and Technology, Nirjuli, National Institute of Technology, Yupia and Rajiv Gandhi University Rono Hill, Doimukh are working on scope of job and placement of youths through their institutes. There is no dearth of job for tribal youths of the state but willingness to work differs among the youths. The youths seem to have deep family bonds and home seek that lead them to understanding something else in them. Even if they get job through placements or own efforts and posted outside, they use to come back and reenlist themselves as unemployed. Job placement is a common in Indian Colleges and Universities but effective programme of placement in technical institutes, need to be harnessed and what the students can do is to smart themselves to the opportunity provided through such colleges and institutes.

Realization has to be born

among the youths in their mind to opt employment opportunities in other sectors like Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Air Force, Para Military Forces, BRTF, Railways, and other public sector undertakings and companies/industries where jobs are available but technically employable candidates are not sufficiently available. Even after repeated advertisements, youths hardly apply for jobs in Navy and Air Force, Army and Para Military Forces. Also they lack required qualifications in technical fields in these sectors.

The committee on placement have identified that a permanent cell should be created in identified institutes with a Permanent Professor and with sufficient budgetary support to committee on placement to enhance the employability skills in colleges, create awareness on placement activities, improve students quality at feeder levels by adaptation of psychometric test and other counseling at initial levels, energize industrial policy, review or install employment generation as base in various Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs), signed with companies on power development viz. NHPC, NEEPCO, Reliance etc.

Employment opportunities in government aided private sectors can offer jobs and creation of central digital data base by government would many way create job opportunities. This way employment opportunity can be created and to some extent minimize unemployment problems of the state. Conduct of job fare based on central data base would benefit youths to avail job. The third meeting on Placement Review Committee at Rajiv Gandhi University on 25th July 2018 with Power Point Presentation by Dr. Ani Taggu, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, RGU had focused on various problems and remedies on placements. The views expressed by him other was joined and supported by other members from Department of Labour, Industry, Education, Science and Technology, Placement Cell, NERIST Nirjuli and NIT Yupiacame up with pertinent solutions on way to minimize unemployment channeling through institutional placements.

Culture has influenced Arunachal Church

Arunachal Pradesh is a beautiful virgin state who is incredibly rich in aged tradition. There is, however no written record on those golden assets, so their knowledge is mounted in the form of folklore, chants and story narration. Orally it is exposed during marriage, funeral and any cultural functions. When compared with civilized nations, their information stored through generations is not less than any of the advanced group of people. Whether the Christians of the Land of the Raising Sun realize it or not, this grand century's cultural heritage has tremendously influenced the churches in numbers of her strata. One may agree or not, it plays a vital role in shaping the worship pattern. Their way of belief reflects indigenous lifestyles.

Almost in every village the tribes of Dawn Lit Mountain has a separate bachelor dormitory! They built it by themselves to train their youth or for occasional community use. Generally this community hall is the biggest building in the village. The habit of raising spacious hall has influenced the Arunachal Christians to erect huge churches which is basically the biggest hall in the village. Roughly it is found that the minister is the most beautiful as well as costliest building in the village. In extremely remote villages, though the villagers may not employ CGC sheet or ce-

ment for their residents yet they raise the church building from those materials. Someone rightly testified 'even in isolated village church rope is made up of CGC sheet and floored with cement.'

No single Arunachalee opt bigger profession but they are rather cheerful in giving and hospitality. Helping others is the essential part of their service in social life. Their theory is that when they extend their hand to the needy, the Creator will reward them. The Arunachal Christians do not seek financial aids from outside to erect any structures or run organizations. Their hospitality nature reflects on the welcoming gospel team and materials offered in the cathedral as a part of adoration. They provide their best to the Christian guests in word and deed. In this regard, veteran evangelist evaluates that normally for a feast of a single visitor they butcher chicken, three to five goat/pig. If there are more than ten guests they slaughter cows and some even arrange Mithun. With that they even give visitors their journey expense to reach another destination.

In technical terms from pre-historic period no one fully ruled Arunachalees. The Ahom and the British just reigned from periphery because their administration did not completely penetrate in the tribal society. The habit of living in liberty

or autonomous governance the churches of Island of Peace are governed or lead by the local elders. However, they kept a relationship with the advanced churches of other states especially for mentorship. As they lacked theological institutes for master level course so they depend on other Christians who are deeply rooted in the scripture. 'We depend on them for their sacred knowledge not for any financial aids. Moreover no one tries to offer us any material abets' preached a pioneer leader.

Since the time of their forefather days their political lives in a number of ways line with the present democratic form of government. In olden times they neither bribed to issue degree in their favor nor did the jury delayed for any fee. The meetings were for open participation. Everybody expressed their views as long as they required and it generally concluded after both the parties agreed. After embracing new faith whether knowingly or unknowingly they applied those essence in worship service such as often praying in mass, giving ample of time to the congregation to express personal testimony and presenting special songs and dances. Thus, the culture influenced the church in reciprocating Arunachal Christians in strengthening the cultural heritage in their worship.

CIRCULAR

This is for general information of all concerned that the Government of Arunachal Pradesh has formulated and adopted the Arunachal Pradesh Advertisement Policy 2018. As per this Policy, all Government Departments, offices, Institutions, Public Sector Undertakings, Commissions, Boards, Corporations, Companies and NGOs under Government of Arunachal Pradesh, are required to route all their advertisements invariably through Directorate of Information and Public Relations and follow the following Guidelines.

- All concerned offices/departments shall plan in advance for release of any advertisement and obtain necessary administrative approval from the competent authority and vetting from Law and Finance department as the case may be.
- All advertisements, classified or display shall be sent to DIPR in the format as appended below by email or by special messenger in hard copy as well as in word file (editable soft copy) before seven days from the intended date of publication in the newspapers, except of those related to law and order problems/ natural calamities and matters of urgent nature requiring immediate attention.
- The issuing authority/department shall specifically mention in the covering /forwarding letter the number of newspapers to which the advertisement are to be released. In case of ambiguous forwarding without mentioning the number of newspapers it shall be taken as more than one newspaper and shall be released to at least two local dailies.
- Any advertisements, display or classified shall not be issued to more than three local dailies. While issuing advertisements particularly tenders, all departments need to follow Provisions under General Financial rules (GFR) for maximum publicity. One national or regional daily as the case may be can be included on requisition from the concerned office/ department or as deemed fit by the DIPR. This restriction shall not apply to advertisement of general nature issued by DIPR on special occasions of importance for which prior administrative approval is obtained.
- In cases where departments want their advertisements to be carried in certain newspapers on the ground of maximum possible publicity and reach in the intended target area, the advertisements will be released as per their requirement in one chosen newspaper in addition to issuing the same in another/other newspapers as per roster system.
- Any empanelled local newspaper found to be publishing any government advertisement without being routed/ released through DIPR shall be barred for government advertisement for ten days for first instance and shall be liable for cancellation of empanelment on repeat violation.
- No Government Department or DIPR shall make payment for the bills of advertisements published in the newspapers/periodicals which are not channelized through the nodal agency, the DIPR, unless it is duly approved ex-post facto by the Secretary IPR, after assessing the genuineness and urgency of the advertisement.
- Advertisements which are general in nature and are not time bound shall also be released to local empanelled weeklies and other periodicals by DIPR in consultation with the client department.
- The payment of advertisement bills of general nature and of schemes funded by the state Government for which no separate fund has been earmarked shall be made by the DIPR.
- Advertisement bills of Central Government schemes for which separate fund for publicity is provided shall be forwarded to the concerned office/departments for payment.
